How to come?

Toulouse Blagnac Airport

International class airport, Toulouse Blagnac Airport is the sixth French airport and the fourth outside Paris. It is located in the **near suburb of Toulouse**, 6 kilometers from the city center. The **T2 tramway** line provides access to the **metro line A at the “Arènes” station** and the **metro line B at the “Palais de Justice” station**. The **shuttle bus** provides access to **bus station** and the **Toulouse Matabiau station**.

Toulouse Matabiau Station

Toulouse Matabiau station is the main station in Toulouse. It is located **near the city center**, about 10 minutes on foot, and it is served by line A of the Metro. Its main building is the subject of an inscription as a historic monument since 1984. A **bus shuttle** provides access to **Toulouse Blagnac Airport**.

By car

Toulouse can be reached via the six motorways A61, A62, A64, A68, A621 and A624. You can reach Toulouse from **Bordeaux by 2 hours 30 minutes** via the A62 and the N124, from **Marseille in 4 hours** via the D999, from **Lyon in 5 hours 15 minutes** via the A7, A9 and A61, from **Montpellier in 2 hours 40 minutes** via the A9 and A61 and from **Barcelona in 4 hours 24 minutes** via the AP-7 and the A61.

By bus

Toulouse bus station is located near the train station. **Toulouse Matabiau** and therefore also **metro station “Marengo - SNCF” on line A**. Located in the city center it is the main terminus of many regional, national or national bus lines international.

Carsharing Citiz

There are **27 carsharing stations of the CITIZ cooperative** in the Toulouse conurbation. Each usage is billed by the hour and per kilometer: everything is included. The vehicles offered are available 24 hours a day in the city center.

Self-service bicycle (VélôToulouse)

Set up by the city of Toulouse and JCDecaux since 2007, the bicycle self-service **VélôToulouse** currently has 283 stations and 2,600 bikes. You can use them by the day by taking a 24h subscription. They are recognizable by their colors red and gray.

Self-service bicycle and scooter (Indigo Weel)

The other self-service bike system is not just about bike, because **Indigo Weel** also offers **electric scooters** self service. The particularity of their rental system goes through the use of a smartphone application to geolocate vehicles and unlock them. Unlike VélôToulouse, Indigo Weel does not use a station. Their bikes and scooters are in white and purple.
